	Windows Thin PC Helps reduce the cost of VDI at the endpoint, enabling IT with an enterprise-ready platform to repurpose existing PCs as thin clients.	You may use Windows Thin PC when you have active Software Assurance coverage for the Windows desktop operating system.*
